#### **Job Description**

Job Summary: Provides direct resident care and Directs other staff in providing quality care in accordance with the Philosophy, policies, and procedures of the Nursing Department and facility. Works under the general supervision of the Director of Nursing.

#### **Job Knowledge:**

Knowledge or willingness to learn aspects of gerontological nursing. Skilled in oral and written communication. Knowledge of State and Federal regulations for nursing facilities. Knowledge of the Diagnosis, care plan and the special needs of the residents for which he/she is assigned. Knowledge of the skills and abilities of the staff.

#### **Responsible For:**

Providing direct resident care. Intervening as needed to assure a safe environment for the residents, visitors and staff.  
Supervision of activities and job performance of NaRs and LPNs.  
Documenting residents' status in the medical record. Implementing physician orders including the administration of medications and treatments.  
Delegating nursing care of residents to the appropriate team members.  
Orientating new team members to the floor/shift routines. Assist in resident care needs, as time permits, including: transfers, toileting, feeding, mobility, bathing, grooming, etc. Enforcement of the facilities policies and procedures.

#### **Physical Demands:**

must have good mental/physical health.  
Able to see and hear well. In an eight hour day must be able to do the following:  
stand and walk 7-8 hours, frequently bend, squat, stoop, balance, push, pull and kneel. Lift 30-40 pounds, occasionally 10-25 pounds and use hands for firm grasping. May be exposed to combative residents and nursing hazards such as chemicals, sharps and contagious diseases.

**Special Demands:** Displays caring, compassion and patience in dealing with residents', families, staff and visitors. Must be able to make independent decisions. Demonstrates an ability to implement resident care needs as directed.

**Education:**

Graduate of an accredited school of nursing for RN's and has current RN license. Current certification for Healthcare Provider CPR.

**Background and Experience:**

Exposure to Nursing Services. Experience in Long Term Care preferred but not required.
